



# CiTY Spring 2021 REC Procedures and Protocols

CiTY's top priority is to keep our players and community as safe as possible.

## Players

All players will have their own distanced spot designated by a cone, by which they will put their own belongings (bag, ball, water, hand sanitizer). No equipment is to be shared. Only coaches can move cones, goals, and other field equipment. Players do not touch any equipment other than what they bring.

**Masks** – Mandatory when arriving to and leaving from the field. Not mandatory while playing soccer or on the field receiving instruction. When at their cone, sitting or taking a break, a mask is not mandatory as the cone areas are appropriately distanced.

**Distancing** – When not playing, players are distanced. Instructions to groups will be kept to a minimum to avoid extending periods of gathering.

## Parents/Families/Spectators

**Two spectators allowed per player (as of Howard County order issued on March 12, 2021)**

**Masks** – Mandatory when in attendance at a practice or game.

**Distancing** – Spectators arriving together, stay together, and distance at least six feet from other spectators while at a practice or game. Per Howard County's March 12 order, spectators must stay outside of fence perimeter and will not be permitted inside the fence or on the field. Bleachers will be open at 50% capacity for spectators.

## Coaches

**Masks** – Mandatory at all times.
